REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR ALL CAMPS IS MAY 20TH.

Registration fee of \$70 and medical information MUST accompany application for processing. A balance of \$65 for campers and \$30 for Volunteer Personnel will be due upon arrival. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR ALL CAMPS IS MAY 20TH.**

HOUSING: Campers and Volunteer Personnel from the same church will be housed together (males & females in separate quads). Special needs or handicapped housing is limited, but available for Campers or Volunteer Personnel needing it while attending camp. These requests needs to be in the office early to secure rooms.

CHECK-IN TIME FOR REGISTRATION AT CAMP:

Camps 1, 3 & 5: Sunday from **1:30 - 4:00 PM. Orientation 4:00 PM.**

Camps conclude at 9:00 AM Wednesday.

Camps 2, 4 & 6: Wednesday from **1:30 - 4:00 PM. Orientation 4:00 PM.**

Camps conclude at 9:00 AM Saturday.

What To Bring: Twin sheets, pillow, blanket, sunscreen, swimsuit & cover-up/beach towel, soap, washcloth, towel, toothbrush & paste, comb, spending money. Write name on belongings. Campers, please do not bring nice clothes or keepsake Bibles (they get lost). Scripture made available in chapel services.

INSURANCE: Every camper NEEDS health insurance coverage. Go to adph.org or chipmedicaid.org to obtain insurance.

VISITS & CALLS: Campers may call home, or receive calls at 205.629.6279 only in case of an emergency. Every year, numerous camper's mail arrives after the camper has left to go home. Please keep this in mind when sending mail.

DRESS CODE: Casual dress is appropriate. Knee length shorts and pants are acceptable for evening services. No backless tops, halter tops or halter top dresses, belly shirts or short-shorts allowed at any time during camp. Volunteer Personnel are expected to dress appropriately and with modesty. Shorts should cover at least 2/3 of your thigh. If sports shorts do not cover, then they are not acceptable for you to wear.

DIRECTIONS: Springville Camp and Conference Center—3886 Mountain View Rd. Odenville, AL 35120 (205)-629-6279

From South: From 459, take I-59 N towards Gadsden. Go approximately 15 miles. Take the Argo Exit-# 148 off of I-59. At the exit ramp turn right Go to the dead end and turn left onto Hwy 11. Approximately 4 miles down, you will see the Springville Camp & Conference Center sign. Turn right onto Mountain View Rd. **STOP** at railroad crossing. Cross the railroad tracks and approximately 4 miles up you will see the camp on your right.

From North: Take I-59 South. Exit at the Springville/Odenville Exit-# 154. At the exit ramp turn right. Go until you come to a 4 way stop in Springville, and turn left onto Hwy. 11. About 4 miles down turn left onto Mountain View Road. **STOP** at railroad crossing. Cross the railroad tracks and about 4 miles up you will see the camp on your right.
